It was decided to conduct BOS meetings by October 2025.




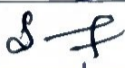

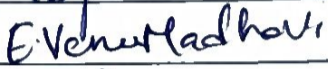



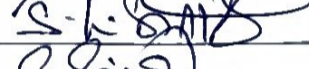
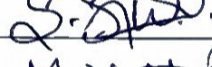
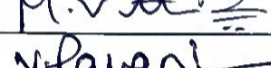
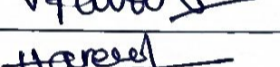
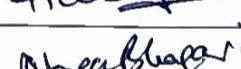
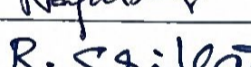
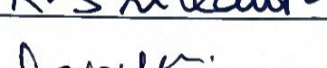
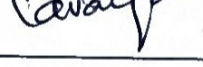

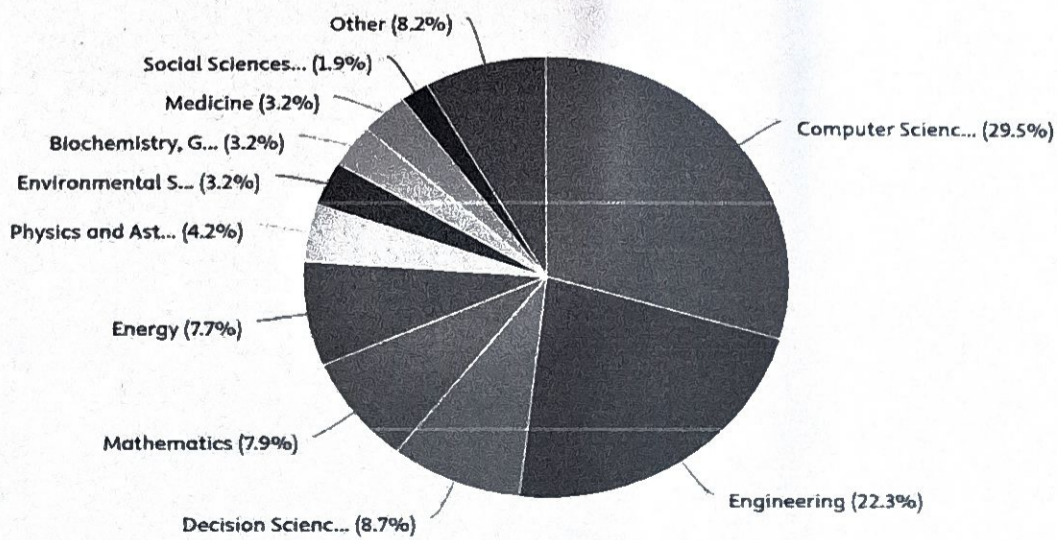
